

## South Africa's Population on 2 February 2022



### 61,2% of South Africa's population is under 35 years old.












## Persons aged 5–24 years attending school increased by 3% from 70,1% in 1996 to 73,4% in 2022.



Population aged 5–24 by school attendance by age, Census 2022




Population aged 20 years and older by educational attainment, Census 1996–2022








### South African quarterly GDP over time


Gross domestic product (GDP), Q4: 2023



Annual GDP growth rate (constant 2015 prices)










### In **1994 manufacturing contributed 23%** to economic activity in SA. By 2022 this was **13,7%**

Contribution by industry ranked over selected time periods





## **The official unemployment rate** stands at **32,1 %,** an increase of 0,2 of a percentage point in Q4:2023 compared to Q3:2023.



## **The expanded** unemployment rate **decreased by 0,1** of a percentage point to **41,1%** when comparing Q4:2023 and Q3:2023.

**Graduate** unemployment rate increased by 1,1 percentage points to **9,6%** in Q4:2023 compared to 8,5% in Q3:2023. Those with **less than matric** remain vulnerable with an unemployment rate of 38,6% which is higher than SA official unemployment rate.



Official Unemployment rate by level of education, Q4:2023











## Youth aged **15-34 years** are more vulnerable to unemployment when compared to older age groups



**OFFICIAL** unemployment rate by population group, Q4:2023








## Black African women continue to be the most vulnerable with an unemployment rate of 38,6% in Q4:2023. This is 4,2 percentage points higher than the national average for all women at 34,4%.

Employment by industry Q4:2023



Employment by industry Q4:2023 vs Q1 2008






#### Employment by occupation Q4:2023
